




This recording project consists of two albums, bringing together two contrasting but complementary visions of the Four Seasons: the original version by Antonio Vivaldi and the contemporary composition by Max Richter, a German composer associated with the post-minimalist movement.

The structure of this recording is based on a powerful idea: to bring two masterpieces into dialogue through the interpretation of four Lithuanian violin soloists, each embodying a season. The program is published on two separate discs - one devoted to the work of Vivaldi, the other to that of Richter - in order to offer a clear listening experience that respects the musical identity of each composer.

The artistic direction has been entrusted to a Baltic chamber orchestra, whose tradition in the Baroque repertoire and contemporary precision are for a reading that is at once lively, embodied and rigorous. For the orchestra of Klaipeda (Lithuania), the aim is to bring a new breath of fresh air and a rare involvement in this demanding repertoire.

The project is aimed at two audiences: music lovers curious to rediscover Vivaldi in a new light, and contemporary music lovers sensitive to modern rewritings of the classical heritage.

By showcasing talented European soloists and a top-class Baltic orchestra, this production defends a demanding, committed and original approach to the great repertoire.


